



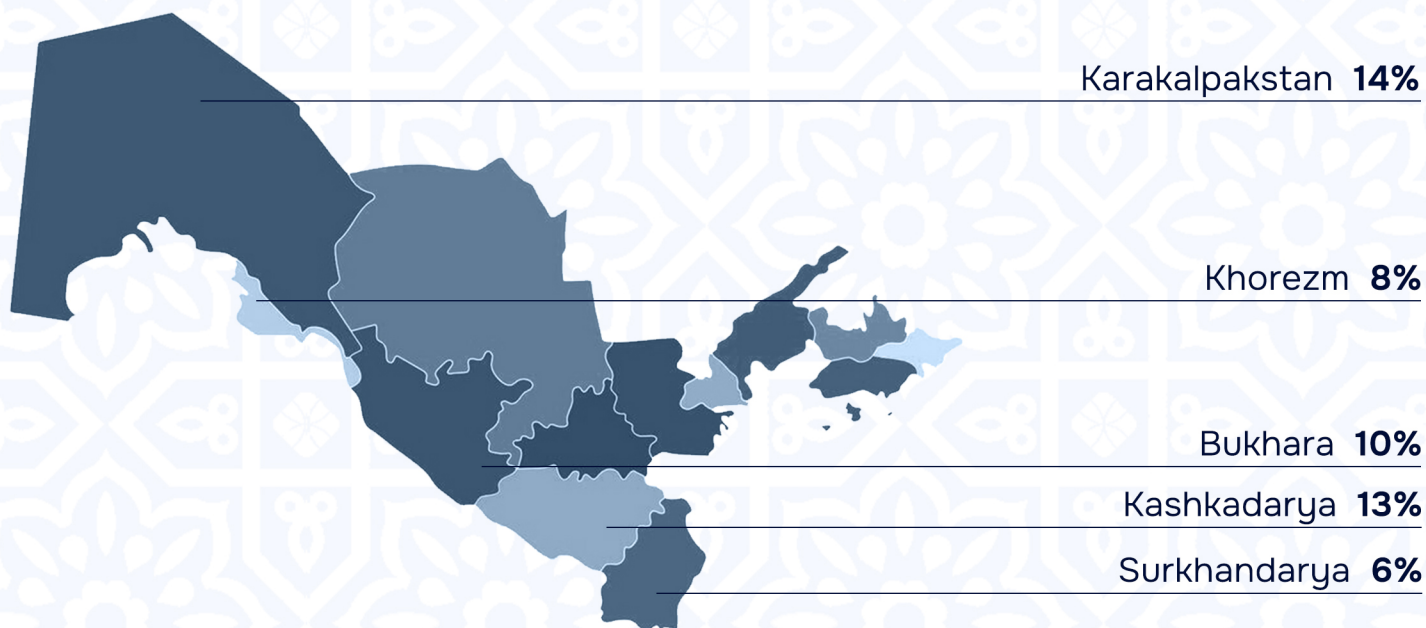

Trends in Women’s Academic Participation Across TSUULL Faculties (Last Three Years)

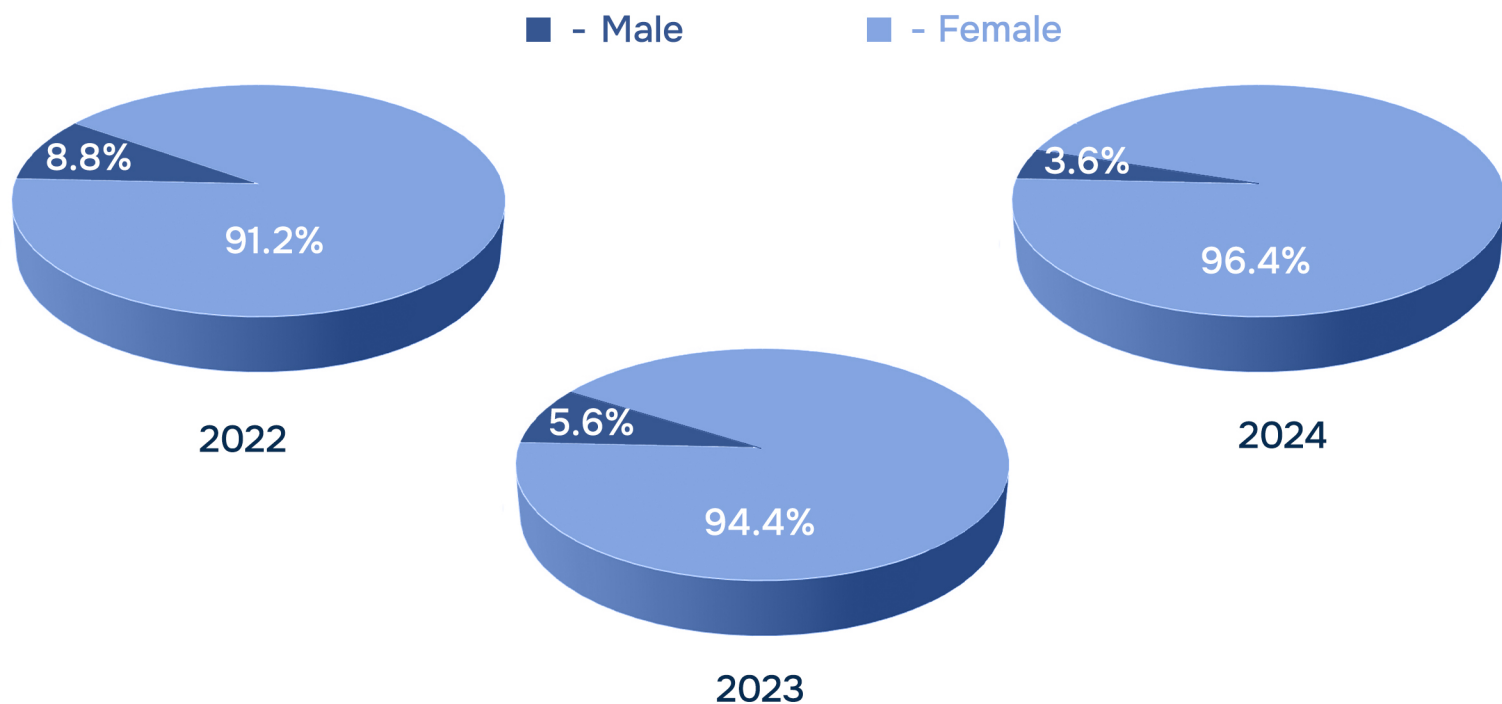

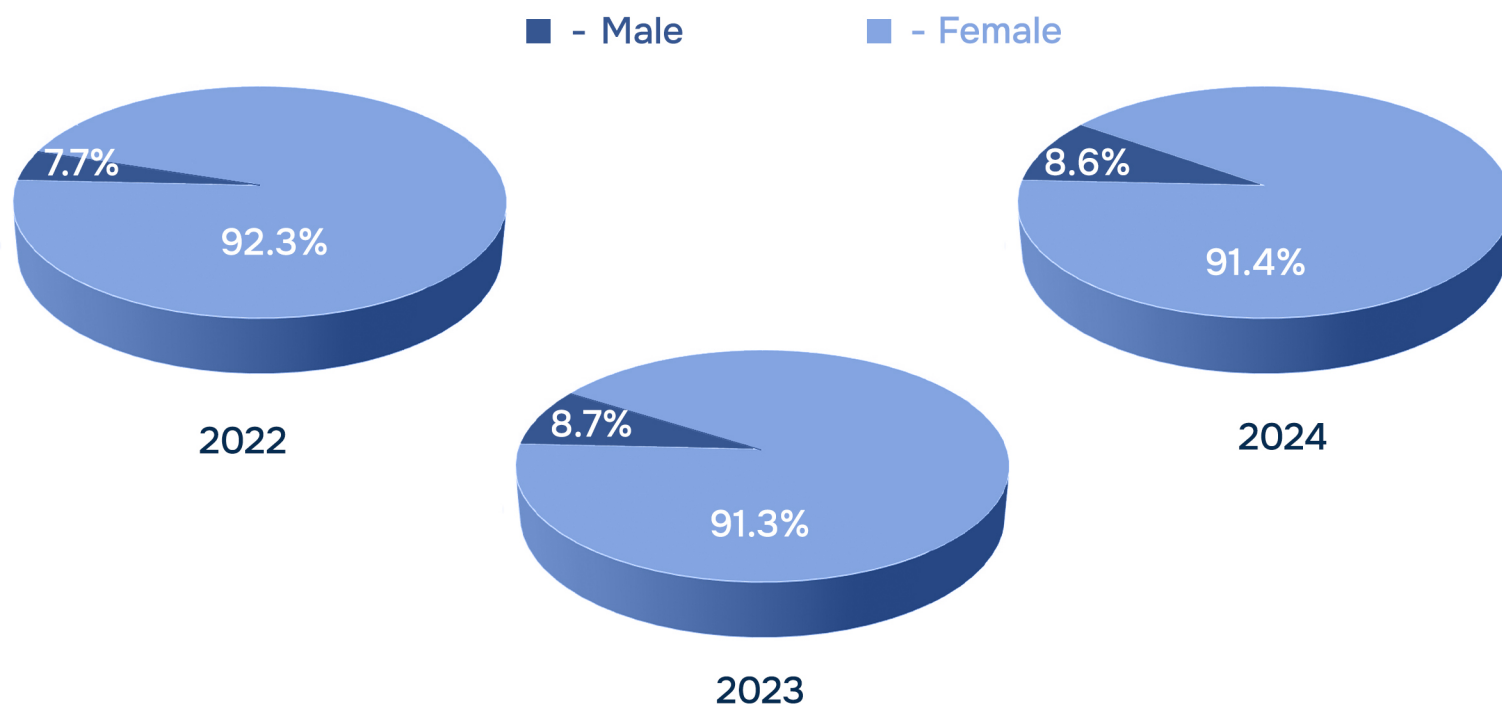


At TSUULL, we consistently monitor and analyse women's enrolment rates, as well as their graduation outcomes, as demonstrated in the data below.
