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Ilyos Ismoilov is Doctor of Philology and Professor, a member of the University Council and has been serving as the Secretary of the University Council at Alisher Navo'i Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature since January 13, 2025.

He began his professional career in 2014 as a lecturer at the Department of Uzbek Literature, Tashkent State Pedagogical University. From 2016 to 2017, he worked at the Department of History of Uzbek Literature and Textology at Alisher Navo'i Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature. Between 2017 and 2019, he was a doctoral student at the Department of History and Folklore of Uzbek Literature, later serving as a senior lecturer from 2019 to 2020.
