



Ilyos Ismoilov Abdukayumovich

Secretary of the Council at TSUULL, Doctor of Philology, Professor Ilyos Ismoilov is Doctor of Philology and Professor, the member of University Council and has been serving as the Secretary of the University **Alisher** Council at Navo'i Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature since January 13, 2025.

He began his professional career in 2014 as a lecturer at the Department of Uzbek Literature, Tashkent State Pedagogical University. From 2016 to 2017, he worked at the Department of History of Uzbek Literature and **Textology** at Alisher Navo'i Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature. Between 2017 and 2019, he was a doctoral student at the Department of History and Folklore of Uzbek Literature, later serving as a senior lecturer from 2019 to 2020.

From 2021 to 2022, he continued his doctoral studies at the Department of History of Uzbek Literature, and in 2023-2024, served as Associate he Professor. Since 2024, he has Professor been at the Department of History Textology of Uzbek Literature, various academic holding positions over the years.

Dr. Ismoilov specializes in the study of Alisher Navo'i's works, particularly the Khamsa epics tradition and the of Khamsanavislik. He the author of numerous scholarly articles published both nationally and internationally, including research on Iskandar in Navo'i's works, comparative analyses of historical literary sources, and studies of the structure and introduction Navo'i's of epics.

He has also co-authored and authored monographs such as "Usmon Azim ijodiyoti" (2011), "Badiiy ummon qatralari" (2015), "Alisher Navoiy: qomusiy lugʻat" (2016), as well as other works dedicated to the study of Alisher Navo'i and Uzbek literary history.
