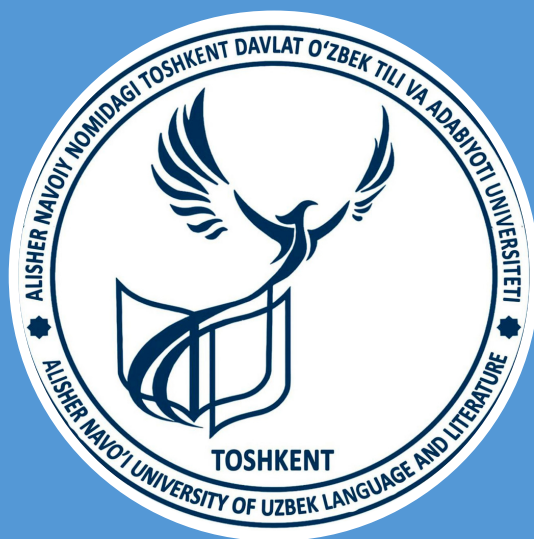

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INFORMATION LETTER

In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated October 20, 2020 No.PF-6084 “On measures for the further development of the Uzbek language and improvement of language policy in our country” in order to ensure the fulfillment of the tasks defined in the “Concept for the development of the Uzbek language and improvement of language policy for 2020-2030”, Tashkent state university of Uzbek language and literature named after Alisher Navo’i on October 18, 2025 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan invites you to a traditional international scientific and practical conference on the topic “Issues of development of the Uzbek language and international cooperation”.

Goals and objectives of the scientific and practical conference:

- increasing the role and prestige of the Uzbek language at the international level;
- analysis of theoretical and practical issues of the Uzbek language;
- studying and developing the interaction of the Uzbek language with Turkic and other languages;
- informing the general scientific community about the achievements in the field of studying and educating the Uzbek language;
- strengthening international cooperation in the field of linguistics;
- expanding the scope of research in modern areas of linguistics.
- to determine the perspective of international relations in the field of linguistics.

The Conference operates in the following departments:

- Theoretical issues of Uzbek linguistics and linguistics.
- Problems of applied linguistics and linguodidactics.
- Intercultural dialogue and the development of the Uzbek language.
- Teaching the Uzbek language abroad and issues of interaction.
- The history of language and Turkic language studies.

Languages used at the conference: Turkic languages, English, Russian languages.

The form of participation in the conference: traditional / remote.

To participate in the conference:

Scientific articles and abstracts should be sent to the organizing committee's email address by October 10, 2025. Articles and abstracts submitted later than the specified deadline, which do not correspond to the topic and direction of the conference, and which do not meet the established requirements, will not be accepted. Articles and abstracts are checked by the anti-plagiarism program.

Publication of conference materials:

The selected materials are published as materials of the international scientific and practical conference on the topic “Development of the Uzbek language and issues of international cooperation” and are published as an electronic collection (PDF). The conference materials are indexed in the international Google Scholar database and assigned a DOI number. Only those scientific articles and abstracts that have been reviewed and recommended for publication are published. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to edit the materials technically, as well as to refuse to comment in cases where the article is not accepted.

The total contribution for the publication of the article is 200,000 (two hundred thousand) soums.

Articles devoted to topical issues and highlighting important scientific innovations are published in the journal “Uzbekistan: Language and Culture”, which is included in the list of the Higher Attestation Commission at TSUULL.

The participants of the conference are awarded a certificate.

Requirements for the design of the article:

- the title of the article should not exceed 12 words;
- for 1 interval below the title, the author's surname, first name and patronymic are indicated; to the right under the link (*), the academic degree, title, name of the organization, position and email address are indicated;
- the length of the article and abstracts should be at least 3-7 pages;
- the text of the article is formatted in dos format, 1 interval, 30 mm on the right side, 15 mm on the left side, 20 mm each on top and bottom, Times New Roman font 12 pins in Latin (for articles in Uzbek);
- an abstract of 100-150 words in the language in which the article is written, and English, as well as 7-10 keywords;
- the text of the article is written in two intervals below the keywords;
- abstracts and articles should be at least 3-7 pages long.;
- the text of the article is formatted in doc format, 1 interval, 30 mm on the right side, 15 mm on the left side, 20 mm on the edges above and below, Times New Roman font 12 pins in Latin (for articles in Uzbek).

The procedure for providing references and used literature:

- the link to the source is given in large brackets in the order in which the surname, year of publication and page of the author are indicated. Example: [Nurmonov, 2012: 56].
- there should be at least 5 references, and a list of them (in the above order) is given at the end of the text.
