From 2017 to 2018, she served as a lecturer at the "Philosophy and Fundamentals of Spirituality" Department of the Tashkent Institute of Chemical Technology, and from 2019 to she 2021 doctoral was а researcher at the institute's Department Social of and Political Sciences. Beginning in 2022, she worked as a lecturer at the Department of Social and

Humanitarian Sciences of the Tashkent State University of Uzbek and Language Literature, later serving as a senior lecturer in 2023-2024, and, from April 2025, as Acting Associate Professor of the department. In 2024. she successfully defended her PhD dissertation in Political Science, specializing in 23.00.04 International Relations. Political Issues of Global and Regional Development. In her research titled "The Role of Uzbekistan-Kazakhstan Interstate Relations in Strengthening Regional Cooperation," she has published nearly 30 articles and theses in national and international journals. Her monograph titled "The Role of Uzbekistan-Kazakhstan Relations Interstate in Strengthening Regional Cooperation" was published in 2025.
